




# Traditional IPOs

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Slow start to the year with only nine companies completing their IPO raising less than \$2 billion with one offering contributing to more than 50% of the total proceeds raised for the month. Private equity firm, **TPG Partners,** raised \$1 billion by offering 33.9 million shares at \$29.50 each.

There were **37** filings in January but only **13** looking to raise over \$100 million. **Four** of the offerings were from the **energy** sector including renewable energy company, **REV Renewables**. Significant volume for energy companies given there were only 6 energy IPOs for the full year of 2021. More than a handful of companies withdrew their offering in the month due to market conditions and M&A including **Authentic Brands**. Authentic Brands announced last year it was receiving a \$3.5 billion funding round from **CVC Capital Partners** and **HPS Investment Partners**. Its reported the Company may pursue an offering in the



### SPACs

25 SPACs went public in January raising close to \$5 billion\*, a 50% decrease to last month by volume and 42% decrease by proceeds. A total of **592** SPACs are now searching for their business combination with approximately **\$143 billion**\* in trust.

Sixteen **SPACs** publicly filed for an IPO in January bringing the total number of SPACs in the **pipeline** to 236. January had a historical number of SPACs withdraw or be declared abandoned, as many were on file for more than nine months and had yet to become effective. A total of **21** SPACs withdrew or abandoned.




### 2021-2022 SPAC Activity



### **De-SPACs**

January had 10 SPACs **announce** their business combination with 6 having an enterprise value of over **\$1 billion.** The largest merger announced in the month was **Cohn Robbins'** announced business combination with **Allwyn Entertainment** for **\$9.3 billion**. There were 2 SPACs who **terminated** their agreement; **Omnichannel** mutually terminated its agreement with **Kin Insurance** citing unfavorable market conditions as well as **Pioneer Merger** and **Acorns**. According to news reports, both targets may pursue the traditional IPO path.




### Announced & Terminated Business Combinations

### **De-SPACs**

**Ten** SPACs **completed** their business combination in January with a total enterprise value of approximately **\$20 billion.** This is the third time in the past 6 months public debuts via a SPAC merger surpassed the number of traditional IPOs. The largest SPAC merger for the month was UK-based **Super Group's** merger with **Sports Entertainment** at an enterprise value of \$4.64 billion.
